Confirmation will be held on Pentecost Sunday, May 31, 2020 at 9:30 a.m. service. The second-year students will confirm their faith and the first-year students will service as worship assistants and petitioners during the service.

Attendance Expectations

It is my expectation that Confirmation students will attend all Confirmation events. Please add the events on this schedule to your family's calendar now and recognize that your child is expected to attend all events in their entirety. Failing to attend events, lessons, and worship opportunities or leaving things early is very disruptive to the group and causes your child to miss important material and experiences. If

your child has to miss a Confirmation class, please let me know as far in advance as possible. I will provide make up work so that your child does not miss important material. However, make up work cannot replace being there for lessons or experiencing worship, retreats, and lock-ins in person. Please alert me as soon as possible if you know that your child will miss something. The Confirmation program is designed to be completed in two years, however, if your child is not able to attend significant events, such as retreats, lock-ins, worship opportunities, or if your child misses an excessive number of Confirmation classes (more than two per semester, without make-up arrangements being made), then his or her Confirmation may need to be delayed so that he or she can pick up important parts of the Confirmation experience in a third or fourth year.

Council Meetings:

According to our constitution, all confirmands must be approved by the Congregational Council for confirmation. In order to meet this requirement, all Confirmation students will be expected to attend one council meeting during their second year of Confirmation. This will give them an opportunity to experience a church council meeting and it will give the church council an opportunity to meet them. Council meetings are usually the fourth Tuesday of the month, but, Pastor Amanda will distribute a schedule of the council meetings to parents and students once the council schedule is set for the year.

Confirmation Camp

Confirmation Camp at Camp Calumet in Freedom, NH is February 7-9, 2020. The total cost of Confirmation Camp is \$100.00 per participant. The church covers \$50.00 of the \$100 fee and families are asked to cover the remaining \$50.00. If this will be a financial hardship to any family, there are scholarship funds available. Please speak to Pastor Amanda.

Weather Cancellation Policy

If Norwood public schools are closed or have early dismissal due to inclement weather, there will be no Confirmation that night. If Confirmation needs to be cancelled due to weather conditions that develop after the school day, you will receive an e-mail and a phone call.
